### **Bedfordshire Youth Choir**

This is a new course aimed at establishing the Bedfordshire Youth Choir for students aged 13 to 20 who have a passion for singing. The choir will be directed by Joss Sanders, Director of Music at Bedford School, supported by a team of vocal coaches. Joss will be taking the choir through an exciting and varied repertoire. This first course is free and there is no requirement for audition though students will be expected to have some experience of singing. Bedfordshire Youth Choir has been invited to sing in a performance of Karl Jenkins's The Armed Man - A Mass for Peace in a highly prestigious concert at The Royal Albert Hall in London on Sunday 28th September 2014.
